Hello Jetties!

I have been encouraged by some members of the class to inform you all about the DM-1 masts I have available for the Jet 14 sailboats.

Our rigging shop builds the DM-1 mast by Dwyer - exactly to class specifications - and ready for installation on your Jet 14. These masts use primarily Selden (formerly Proctor) hardware and include very strong, fully adjustable spreaders (pre-set at 17-1/4" long), all internal halyards which exit through a 4 sheave mast butt, aerodynamic 'T'-terminal rigging attachments, and also 4 internal sleeves to reinforce the high load hardware. Where possible fittings have been placed to minimize the number of fasteners required, keeping weight out of the rig. All fasteners are stainless steel rivets, screws or bolts. Included with the spar are all halyards and standing rigging with a conventional open turnbuckle for the forestay (or lashing if you prefer). As specified by class rules standing rigging is not adjustable underway with this rig, and the jib halyard purchase is 1:1 to ensure this.

The 4 sheave mast butt requires a 2-3/8" wide deck cut-out and the mast is fit with side plates at partners height to for correct fit. The bottom end of the standing rigging will need to be terminated locally, due to the wide range of builders for these boats over the past 40+ years.

- New England Ropes T-100 covered 'Technora' Main and Jib halyards
- New England Sta-Set Spinnaker and Pole Lift halyards
- 1by19- 3/32" standing rigging with Stai-Master turnbuckles on side shrouds, conventional turnbuckle for forestay.
