

2007 JET 14 DISTRICT IV CHAMPIONSHIP

NOTICE of RACE- July 21-22, 2007

1. **Invitation:** This event is organized by Jet 14 Fleet 63 and the Mayfield Yacht Club (MYC). MYC is located on The Great Sacandaga Lake and is approximately 50 miles NW of Albany, NY.
2. **ELIGIBILITY:** All skippers should be a 2007 member in good standing of the Jet 14 Class. Co-helming is allowed for this regatta.
3. **REGISTRATION – FEES & MEASUREMENT:** Registration fee is \$25 and includes a Dinner Saturday Evening and continental Breakfast on Sunday. As this event is also in the spirit of fleet and class building in the Northeast, non-compliant boats will be allowed to race at the chief measurer's discretion but will not qualify for the District IV championship.
4. **SCHEDULE of EVENTS:**

Boats will be launched at Gordon's Lakeside Marina (Formerly Ryan's) and may be dropped off there as they arrive. Greg will have an area roped off near the road for Jet use.

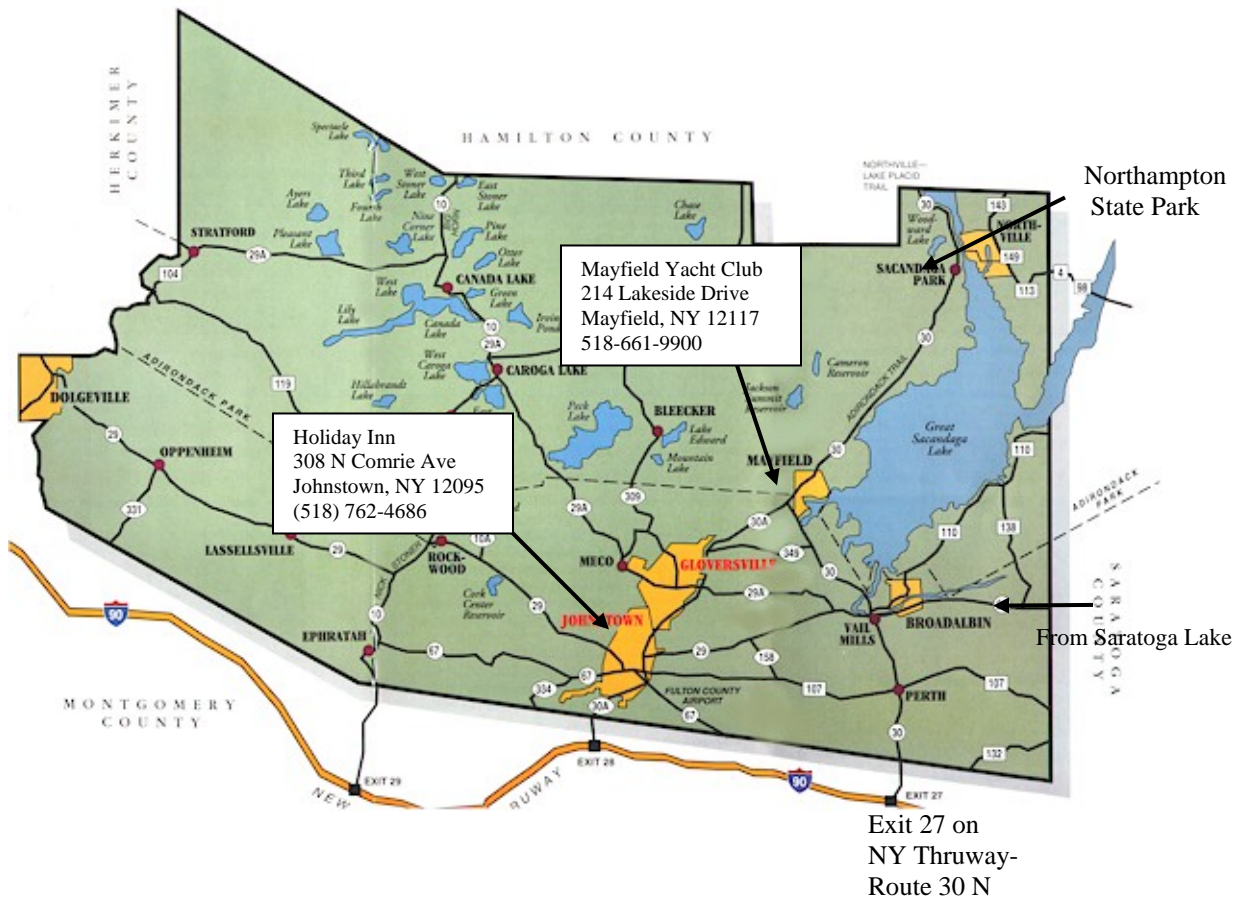

5. **AWARDS:** Awarded at the ratio of 1 per 3 boats entered in the regatta.
6. **BOAT STORAGE AND LAUNCHING:** Boats may be stored and launched from designated areas. Gordon's Lakeside Marine (322 Lakeside Drive, Mayfield, NY 12117) has agreed to provide in/out and overnight storage at their facility. Phone- 518-661-5031. Sailors wishing to leave their boats (i.e. triple trailer) in the NE may do so between Sail Newport and this regatta. Directions to Mayfield Yacht Club/The Great Sacandaga Lake



From East on Route 90 (NY Thruway)-
Take Exit 27 north through Amsterdam. Continue on 30 in Broadalbin past the Fulton County Welcome Center at Route 29. Shortly after the 29/30 intersection, make a left turn to continue on route 30 at the flashing light. Approximately 2 miles later, turn right onto School Street in Mayfield (Shortly past the Fuel-n-Food Citgo station on left, which has great subs if you need to stop on the way or pack a lunch.) Cross over bridge/dam and turn right onto Lakeside Drive. The Mayfield Yacht Club is on the right. Gordon's Lakeside Marine is the 2nd marina past the club. (approx .5 miles)

From West on Route 90 (NY Thruway)
Take Exit 28 North to Route 30A. Follow 30A through Fonda, Johnstown, and Gloversville. Turn Right on Main Street (At Stewarts) and left onto Lakeside Drive.
