Open Division, Sunday, July 29

RULES

The Jet-14 “Wren Wregatta” will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008 (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, the Jet Class Association Rules, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

ELIGIBILITY

- ◆ The “Wren Wregatta” is open to all Jet-14 sailboats.
- ◆ To qualify as a “Junior” boat, both skipper and crew may not turn 20 years old in 2007.
- ◆ To qualify as a “Novice” boat, the skipper may not regularly skipper a Jet 14. All sailors are eligible to crew on a “Novice” boat.
- ◆ **Short course races on Saturday morning will NOT count in the regatta scoring. All boats race in the Open Division on Sunday – 5 races weather permitting.**

REGISTRATION

Official registration for both events will take place from 8 to 9 AM at the HSC area in the Spruce Run Recreation Area on the day of the event. Coffee and donuts will be available. Please bring your own lunch; beverages (soda and water) will be available.

BOAT STORAGE

Boats may be stored overnight July 28 at Spruce Run for those participating in the regatta.

RACE COURSE

The race course(s) will be on Spruce Run Reservoir

Alternate penalties will be according to RRS 44.2 (720 Rule).

SCORING

The series will be scored as provided in Appendix A of the RRS using the Low Point System. One race constitutes a regatta. There will be no throw-outs on either day.

AWARDS

Awards will be presented to the top three skippers and crews in the Junior and Novice Divisions on Saturday and in the Open Division on Sunday.
