- This summer's NC Governor's Cup regatta is the 54th to be held since its inauguration in 1957, distinguishing it as one of the oldest, largest and most venerable in the Southeast. The Regatta includes up to five races over two days. It takes place off Henderson Point on Kerr Lake, known for its expanse of inland water, beautiful tree-lined shores, great family camping and easy access from Interstate 85.

DIRECTIONS

Henderson Point State Recreation Area is located on Kerr Lake near the VA-NC border 15 miles north of Henderson NC (Lat 36.32.20N Long 78.20.34W). From I-85 or US 1 at Henderson, follow NC 39 north. Two miles north of Townsville, turn right onto SR 1356. Then, about three miles further, turn right on to SR 1359. follow signs to the Henderson Point State Recreation Area.

JURISDICTION AND RULES

The Regatta will be governed by the **rules** as defined in the **Racing Rules of Sailing** for 2009-2012. The Regatta is a Category A event. Sailing instructions will be provided at registration.

CLASS AND COMPETITION

The Carolina Sailing Club welcomes one-design centerboard and catamaran classes to compete for the Governor's Cup. Four boats registered in a given class will guarantee scoring and a trophy for that class. Invited classes include, but are not limited to:

Buccaneer	Flying Scot	Isotope	420	Laser
Lightning	505	Tanzer 16	Thistle	Wayfarer

Fleets of fewer than 4 boats per class will compete under US Sailing Portsmouth handicapping rules in: Open Monohull and Open Multi-hull. Judgments, exceptions, and adjustments to handicaps will be at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

Fleet trophies will be awarded according to the low-point scoring system of Appendix A4. A boats series score shall be the total of all her races. This changes RRS A2. Five races are scheduled; one race shall constitute a regatta.

Trophies will be awarded to a class based on the number of boats in a class—

(1-4 boats) 2 trophies, (5-9 boats) 3 trophies, (10 or more boats) 4 trophies

The NC Governor's Cup is a perpetual trophy engraved with the name of the skipper in his/her class having the best average score based on the NC Governor's Cup high point scoring system. A keep trophy will also be presented.

FEES AND REGISTRATION

Discounted fees are offered at online registration thru June 15th www.carolinasailingclub.org

A \$6 gate fee is collected at the Henderson Point Gate House for those not having an annual pass.

Four boats in a class must be registered by 1030 am on Saturday to qualify for separate scoring and trophies for that class. Late registrations may be allowed at the scorekeeper's discretion, but late registrants will not affect the number of separate classes scored.
